NBG Report for KCC Meeting 16 Nov 2016

Again there have been no significant changes over the last month. However, Stirling Council has arranged a further Broadband Supplier Event with the aim of bringing together poorly connected individuals and businesses in our local area, and the suppliers of alternative technologies. This will be on Wednesday 7th Dec at Balfron High School starting at 6pm. It will consist of a series of presentations from suppliers followed by the opportunity for a closer Q&A. It is hoped to be able to target invitations specifically at those premises most directly affected in addition to providing more general publicity via notice boards and in Killearn Courier. The R100 report, outlining how everyone in Scotland can receive 30Mbps is now not expected to be public knowledge until Spring and until then it is very hard to determine how broader progress will be made to supply fibre speeds to the majority of premises in the village via the Digital Scotland programmes.

- Another month has gone by without any work starting on the Crosshead Rd cabinet. The cabinet suggested at a location near Baptiston Farm is still shown as live by June 2017;
- Digital Scotland and BT Openreach both have updated WhereandWhen websites showing the roll-out process for an individual location. This allows a clearer view of the upgrade process. Premises shown to be in the early stages of the upgrade process, however, do not appear to be consistent with other available information;
- Digital Scotland continues to create the R100 requirement report, identifying the work required to bring 30Mbps+ to everyone in Scotland. They are currently conducting reviews with potential suppliers as to how this might be achieved and will go to Public Consultation about the Intervention Areas in the Spring. The first contracts are still expected to be awarded early in 2017, although reference to "Intervention Areas" raises concerns that not all remaining premises will be covered;
- The latest Broadband Delivery Group meeting was held last week where updates on the various focus topics were given. There were no revelations and both of the focus projects continue to run into bureaucratic difficulties of one kind or another. The upgrade proposed for the Ben Gullipen mast, that might provide a wireless route to Balfron premises for example, is now being delayed over legal concerns about site ownership and is in danger of being abandoned;
- Stirling Council Broadband Delivery Group site now has a list of currently active Community Broadband projects in the region. Concern was expressed at the BDG meeting though about the long delays and bureaucratic process that was involved with following the CBS route to deliver a better connection;
- The Digital Scotland "Better Broadband Scheme" provides a subsidy to establish a better connection using either satellite or wireless for those currently getting download speeds of less than 2Mbps. See the KCC website for specific links;
