NBG Report for KCC Meeting 19 Oct 2016

There is very little to report this month as there are no significant changes. The R100 report, outlining how everyone in Scotland can receive 30Mbps as outlined by the Scottish Government earlier this year, is eagerly awaited and until then it is very hard to determine how broader progress will be made to supply fibre speeds to the majority of premises in the village.

- Another month has gone by without any work starting on the Crosshead Rd cabinet. The cabinet suggested at a location near Baptiston Farm is still shown as live by June 2017;
- Digital Scotland and BT Openreach both have updated WhereandWhen websites showing the roll-out process for an individual location. This allows a clearer view of the upgrade process. Premises shown to be in the early stages of the upgrade process however do not appear to be consistent with other available information;
- Digital Scotland, as far as we aware, continue to create the R100 requirement report, identifying the work required to bring 30Mbps+ to everyone in Scotland. The report is still expected by the end of 2016, with the first contracts awarded early in 2017;
- Direct contact has been made with the Broadband representative on Strathblane Community Council and this may create a larger user base to explore alternative provisions;
- Blairessan developers Mactaggart & Mickel have been alerted to a new BT Openreach initiative to bring FTTP to all new developments with more than 30 premises;
- Stirling Council Broadband Delivery Group site now has a list of currently active Community Broadband projects in the region;
- Further reports and comment on the Digital Scotland programme have come available i.e. Carnegie Trust report on
 Digital Participation and Social Justice in Scotland, and a press article by Lesley Riddoch in The National, and a BBC
 Scotland Radio news item this week provided alternative views of the current programme from service users and
 Brendan Dick of BT Openreach. See KCC website for links;
- The Digital Scotland "Better Broadband Scheme" provides a subsidy to establish a better connection using either satellite or wireless. See the KCC website for specific links;
- A further Broadband Supplier event meeting, aimed at this specific area, and affected individuals, is proposed by Stirling Council for early December at Balfron High school. No firm details are available yet however;
