Kerse Road: Full closure 16th April

Kerse Road Bridge will close fully to traffic at 6am on Monday 16th April. During the closure the all vehicle diversion route will be in place, as detailed on the map.

Access to Springkerse Industrial Estate will be maintained at all times during the works using the diversion route.

The temporary pedestrian bridge will open to pedestrians and cyclists as the road bridge closes. For safety reasons cyclists will be required to dismount and walk across the structure.

Network Rail is hosting community drop ins prior to and during the first week of the closure. These are for anyone to attend and are an opportunity to find out more about the project.
