NOTICE OF COMMUNITY COUNCIL ELECTIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election to **Killlearn Community Council** will be held between January and April 2010 in accordance with the National Model Scheme for the Establishment of Community Councils. The election is to be held to fill **One (1)** vacancy on the Community Council.

Anyone wishing to stand as a Candidate at these elections must be over 16 years of age and resident within the Killlearn Community Council Area. All Candidates over the age of 18 must also be on the current Electoral Register for the Killlearn Community Council Area. Candidates between the ages of 16 and 18 who cannot yet appear on the Electoral Register must produce photographic proof of residency (eg Young Scot Card, passport etc). Anyone who is uncertain as to whether they are eligible to stand or vote in the election should contact the Community Council Election Office, Room 53, Old Viewforth, Stirling 01786 442759.

Nomination forms can be collected from the Election Office or from libraries. Forms can also be obtained from the Stirling Council website at www.stirling.gov.uk. All forms must be duly completed and returned (on paper, as electronic copies will not be accepted) to the Election Office by 4pm on Friday, 26 February 2010. Any candidates being elected will serve until the next general set of elections for Community Councils in October 2013.

Any Candidate submitting a valid nomination form who subsequently wishes to withdraw their nomination should do so on the appropriate form, which is also available from the Election Office by 5pm on Friday, 26 February 2010.
