

Wheelie Bin Collection

The table shows the two-weekly Thursday cycle of collection for the wheelie bins in Killearn and the other Strathendrick villages.

Remember to minimise your waste in the **grey bin**, which goes to landfill – there should be no waste that can be recycled or composted in this bin. This includes glass, cans, paper and all types of plastic bottles, which all go in the **blue box**. However, do not put plastic cartons, tubs, bags, etc in the blue box, these unfortunately still have to go in the grey bin.

Cardboard, garden waste (weeds, grass cuttings etc.) and kitchen waste which is uncooked (*such as potato peelings, salad residue, etc. which must not have come into contact with meat*) goes in the **brown bin**. All this is taken to Polmaise to be composted.

Remember – no plastics of any type in the brown bin, including plastic sacks or any non-organic matter. At present, hygiene regulations do not allow cooked kitchen waste, or waste that may have come into contact with meats, to go in the brown bin. This should be composted at home, but if this is not possible, wrap and put it in the grey bin. ***If your waste is contaminated, it cannot be composted and will not be collected.***

FREE COMPOST This is now available from the skips in Balfron. You must take your own bags to collect the compost, which has been made from the contents of your brown bins. You may uplift compost at the following times:

- **Monday to Friday 5.00 pm to 8.00pm,**
- **Saturday 10.00 am to 2.00 pm.**
