Paste or type in the reference in the Application Reference box and click the Search button at the bottom. (If you paste and copy be careful not to include any spaces at the beginning or the end of the reference.) This will take you to a page which should contain brief details of the application. You are now into the detail of the planning application, in a tabbed page. Click the tab Associate Documents and the button View Associate Documents. There is a table of all the documents – just click on the document name in the left hand column and it will open as an Adobe Reader® document.
